COVID-19

Due to the high number of positive cases reported in school this week, please remember if your child has any of the three main covid symptoms, high temperature, new continuous cough, loss of sense of taste/smell then please arrange a PCR test for your child and do not attend school until you receive the result.

Children and young people with COVID-19 should not attend their education setting while they are infectious. They should take an LFD test from 5 days after their symptoms started followed by another one the next day. If both these tests results are negative, they should return to their educational setting if they normally attend one, as long as they feel well enough to do so and do not have a temperature. If your day 5 LFD test result is positive, you can continue taking LFD tests until you receive 2 consecutive negative test results.
